- * Conduct or coordinate safety training courses for supervisors.
- * Assist in conducting a program to develop employees' awareness of accident prevention and develop employee skills in the use of safe work techniques and practices.
- * Inspect and recognize hazardous and/or unhealthy working conditions, faulty equipment, and other observable risks. Determine when certain tests are required (i.e., noise level, air quality, etc.).
- * Monitor and ensure the Company's compliance with hazardous waste disposal procedures and requirements (Federal and State).
- * Prepare and maintain required reports.

Special Knowledge & Skills:

1. Identify and manage a variety of chemicals and hazardous materials.
2. Possess excellent command of the English language to comprehend technical journals, government rules and regulation, ordinances and financial reports.
3. Apply principles of logic and/or scientific thinking to define programs, collect data, establish facts and draw valid conclusions.
4. Interpret and apply laws, regulations and procedures specified by OSHA, HIOSH, EPA and other governmental agencies.
